Illness and School Attendance

Sometimes our children become unwell and need to take time off school to recover or to prevent spreading an infection to others in our school. We understand and support this type of absence. You may also wish to consider the following points in relation to illness and school attendance.

- If your child has an underlying medical condition, we are not aware of in school, please talk to the school office urgently to inform us so that we can support you and make appropriate arrangements.
- Try to keep routine medical/dental appointments outside of school hours wherever possible.
- Please give us clear reasons/evidence for all absences at the time of absence so that we
 are able to make an informed decision on authorising absence. If you have not informed
 school of the reason for your child's absence it may be unauthorised even when they were
 ill. (Where a child has more than 5 days of unauthorised absence it may result in further
 action such as a penalty notice being issued.)
- If your child appears to have a lot of time absent from school, due to common childhood illness, we may talk to you to see how we might work together to improve their attendance, we may seek medical advice and a referral to the school nurse may be requested where appropriate to support improved attendance.

Hillside pedestrian and vehicle gates

To ensure the security of our school site we are automating our existing manual gates on Hillside Road to allow permitted access only, via an intercom. We anticipate work starting on the Hillside pedestrian and vehicle gate next week. Please take extra care if accessing that area of the school site at this time.
